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## Introduction to Domestic Energy Efficiency in Northern Ireland Supported E-learning

This CPD accredited e-learning course is designed to provide a basic introduction to domestic energy efficiency for frontline staff providing householders with energy efficiency advice.

The course covers, heating systems and controls, top tips for saving electricity, heat loss in the home and insulation methods and sources of advice and assistance.



**Duration:** 2 weeks to complete

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## City and Guilds Level 3 Award in Energy Awareness 6281-01 Supported E-learning

NEA's widely recognised Level 3 City & Guilds qualification in Energy Awareness is now available as an e-learning qualification with trainer support. This course is designed for staff involved in providing householders with energy efficiency advice. It aims to provide delegates with an understanding of energy advice and the knowledge required to deliver energy advice to householders.

**Duration:** Four weeks.

Delegates receive a set support documents including mock exam papers, activities, and handouts along with a copy of the Energy Advice in the Home textbook. Delegates will go on to sit the exam remotely with an NEA/ City & Guilds registered examiner.
